Completing a degree - non-thesis master's

Unofficial information for CEE graduate students who are in the last semester of their degree program

Do you plan to graduate this semester?

- You are in the final semester of your degree program and plan to apply for your degree and graduate
- Steps to complete degree:
 - Are you registered?
 - Have you applied for your degree?
 - Have you informed Graduate School about commencement attendance?
 - Have you arranged for a final exam with your committee?
 - Have you scheduled the final exam with the Graduate School?
 - Have you checked your progress to degree on HokieSpa?

Steps to complete degree - Are you registered?

- All graduate students planning to graduate MUST be registered in the semester in which they plan to graduate (Fall, Spring, or Summer)
- Registration can be normal registration like courses, project and report hours, research and thesis hours, or research and dissertation hours

OR

- Registration can be SSDE <u>(Start of Semester Defense Exception)</u> a special lower price 1 credit hour for students who only need to take the final exam. Students using SSDE in Fall or Spring must hold the final exam within the first 5 weeks of the semester. Students using SSDE in Summer have the entire Summer semester to hold the final exam.
- Students using SSDE don't register themselves fill out the SSDE form and submit it to Graduate School. Graduate School will register you for the one special SSDE credit hour.

Steps to complete degree - Have you applied for your degree?

- Apply for your degree (AFD = "Application for Degree") on HokieSpa under "Degree Menu"
- AFD charge is \$25
- IF you are not able to complete the AFD on HokieSpa, use the <u>Degree or Certificate Conferral Request Form</u>
- You will have to use this form if you are:
 - Pursuing a simultaneous degree (2 graduate degrees at the same time)
 - A direct PhD student pursuing a MS degree

Contact Graduate Coordinator if you are not able to complete the AFD on HokieSpa - you will have to schedule your final exam in a different way

Steps to complete degree - Have you informed Graduate School about commencement attendance?

- In HokieSpa → Degree Menu, choose "Commencement Intentions Form"
- You can choose to participate in Spring Commencement or Fall Commencement (or not participate at all)
- In HokieSpa → Degree Menu, international students can choose "International Invitation for Commencement Request" to generate an invitation letter for family members who are outside of the US
- Questions about the commencement ceremony should be directed to the Graduate School

Steps to Complete Degree - Have you arranged a final exam with your committee?

- All graduate students hold a final exam this can be a project and report presentation or a coursework only exam
- Arrange a date, time, and location for your final exam with your Chair and committee (some program areas arrange this for coursework only students - ask your program admin)
- Your program admin can help you reserve a room for a project defense
- Pay attention to the Graduate School's deadlines for defending in a semester

Steps to Complete Degree - Have you scheduled your final exam with the Graduate School?

- All graduate students hold a final exam and this must be scheduled with the Graduate School <u>here</u>
- Exams must be scheduled at least two weeks ahead of the exam date
- Graduate School will officially approve the exam and send an email verification to your committee
- Pay attention to the deadlines to defend in a semester

Steps to Complete Degree - Have you checked your degree progress on HokieSpa?

- In HokieSpa → Degree Menu, you can find a graduation checklist monitored by the Graduate School
- Graduate School's What You Need to Graduate
